RULES

Candidates are expected to conduct themselves as representatives of TCC at all times.

1. The candidate must complete the application and the BIO sheet completely.
2. The winner is encouraged to conduct at least 2 fundraisers to benefit Texas Conference of Clubs Lonestar fund. The fundraisers may include shows, raffles, drawings, performances. All raffle tickets must be numbered and accounted for by the title holder. Any funds raised must be accounted for, verified by signature of 3 people and turned in to the conference Vice-chairman.
3. The title holder is a very visible representative of the Texas Conference of Clubs and will conduct himself in the manner of a title holder and representative of the Texas Conference of Clubs at all times. Negative reports of the title holders actions reported to the Texas Conference of Clubs or the conference Vice-chairman will be cause for removal of the title.
4. The title holder is encouraged to wear the sash at any event they attend that is hosted by a club or organization. The title holder is responsible for the safe keeping and condition of the sash. The sash is to be passed on to the next title holder in succession. The title holder is required to attend the annual Lone Star run and be a judge for the contest at that run.
5. The contest winner will receive:
The Miss Lonestar sash
Entries may be turned in upon check in at the Lone Star Run
6. Contest scoring will be done using the Olympic Scoring method with the highest and lowest scores discarded. The remaining scores will be totaled for category points.
7. Contestants acknowledge the decisions of the judges and the contest coordinator are final.
