## Trash Handling Procedure

### Procedure 10-03

The following procedure is to be adhered to at all times relative to the handling and disposal of trash at the Buzzards' Peak Community Land Site. For the purpose of clarification, the term "trash" shall be divided into two categories: "consumable" and "non-consumable." Consumable trash shall include any and all edible food stuffs, as well as paper or plastic products and wood. Non-consumable trash shall include glass, brick, concrete, rubber and any type of metal, including aluminum, galvanized, etc.

1. All parties, be they individuals, groups of individuals, recognized organizations, and TCC Conference shall be responsible for disposing of any and all trash that they might generate while in attendance at the land site.
2. The prescribed manner for disposing of all types of trash shall be by rendering same as compact as possible and deposit it in the provided dumpster.
3. Each and every member of the Conference, as well as invited guests, are responsible for helping maintain the property in as pristine a condition as possible. This should not be considered drudgery or a chore, but, rather, should be a matter of pride with all.
4. From time to time, and at the discretion of the Land Management Committee, signs may be posted designating where and how trash is to be disposed of.
5. No burning of toxic material will be allowed at any time.
6. Burning of consumable trash will not be allowed during runs or leased activities.
7. Burning of consumable trash is permitted during Activity Weekends as needed for maintenance and clean up of property.
8. No disposal of food items will be made other than in trash containers.
