## **April Activity Weekend 4/28-29**

Dispose of old items in the walk in

Rake out ditches and culverts

Power wash interior & exterior walk in cooler

Power wash picnic tables

Power wash steps to Pole Barn

Setup and fill pool

Sweep off leaves from roof tops of buildings and wash out gutter over kitchen

Mow and trim:

- parking lot
- flag pole field
- road from gate to flag pole field
- tenting area
- around TCC mailbox
- path to Buzzards Peak

Build a horseshoe pit between firewood and to rock wall

Assist digging and running water lines from the road to the wellhead.

Spray paint the butt cans around the Landsite so our guests could better locate them.
